

Bottle Top Maths



All you need is some bottle tops and a marker pen!

1. Mark bottle tops with numbers 1 to 10/20.
2. Scatter and ask them to put in order.
3. Ask your child to turn around, remove one. Can they tell you what is missing?
4. Swap 2 numbers. What is wrong?
5. Use different coloured bottle tops and label with mathematical symbols +, - and =. Use them to create mathematical sentences.



6. Arrange the bottle tops to represent a clock face. Add some twigs or lollipop sticks to represent hands.
