

Through singing and acting Nursery Rhymes out with your children you...

- Introduce children to rhyme and alliteration, focussing on their attention to listening to sounds (phonetics in words). Prerequisites to reading.
- Introduces children to simple story structures with a sequence of events of beginning, middle and end.
- Introduces new words and enriches vocabulary
- Cultural and traditional and historical.
- Promote social skills
- Adding actions enables your child to practice fine and gross motor skills – pre-requisites to writing.
