

Simple Visual Memory Games

Tray Game – Kim’s game - [Memory game challenge - YouTube](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=d9IPOV7k88Q) (for adults)

- Place 4 or 5 familiar objects on a tray/area – look, cover, remember, say, check
- For younger children -use a bag instead/feely bag good
- Generation game – conveyor belt - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=d9IPOV7k88Q>
- Variation – remove an item – what’s missing?
- Added challenge - place familiar items in a line and remember items in sequence – remove or swap what’s missing or changed? Start with 3 items increase to 5
- Use as an opportunity to introduce new vocabulary e.g. animal names, shapes
- Link objects to a story book



Pelmanism/Pairs

- Find pairs that are the **same**. Could be as simple as pairing up socks or matching pictures.
- Start with about 5 pairs and increase as you child’s confidence and skill grows.
- Commercial or home-made.
- Variations – pairing rhyming pictures, adult and baby animals, number to number group, shapes, colours, Nursery rhyme characters to an object (e.g. Humpty Dumpty and a wall)
- Can be played as a family and encourages turn taking.
