


Tip Sheet

Look for shapes in the environment, both natural and man-made and both 2D and 3D

Each time search for a different shape. Keep a tally chart of how many you find or record on a simple map.

Give clues such as...

I'm looking for a shape that has 4 straight sides, all sides are equal etc

I'm looking for a shape that has one <u>curved side</u> and 1 <u>straight side</u>.

I'm looking for a shape with 6 faces, some are rectangular, and some are square.
