

### Bubble Prints

You will need ...



1. Mix 1/2 cup of water, 2 tablespoons of paint, and a few squirts of washing up liquid in each bowl.
2. The best idea for younger children to avoid them sucking the paint mixture is cut the top 1/3 off a plastic bottle and use that to blow through instead of a straw.
3. Blow with the bottle or straw into the bowl to make lots of **bubbles** pile up on top of the cup - then press paper to the **bubbles** so they pop and leave **bubble prints!**



You could select colours like **orange**, **yellow** and **red** to make a sunset backdrop. Cover the paper in bubble prints by repetitive printing. Once dry cut out shapes in black paper to create a silhouette effect.

Or **blues** and **greens** to create an underwater backdrop then draw and cut sea animals, seaweed and divers etc. Arrange and glue to backdrop.
