Pointillism – unleash your inner Van Gogh

Pointillism is a technique of painting in which small, distinct dots of colour are applied in patterns to form an image.

All you need is...



Cotton buds, plastic free if possible





plate for mixing colours



fingers





Vincent Van Gogh created this famous painting in 1888/9 by applying the technique of pointillism. He used paint brushes.
